At 14 North Bennet Street, we tackled the challenge of preserving the historical integrity of Leonard's Rectory while re-imagining it for modern residential living. The original facade was meticulously restored, but the integration of rear and roof decks required a delicate approach. Our solution was to introduce a subtle one-story addition that respected the historic architecture while adding functional outdoor spaces, ensuring the new design harmonized with the building's character and the surrounding North End streetscape.

We opened up the floor plans to maximize natural light and flow, while maintaining key historical elements. Modern systems were discreetly incorporated using advanced techniques to ensure both comfort and preservation.
