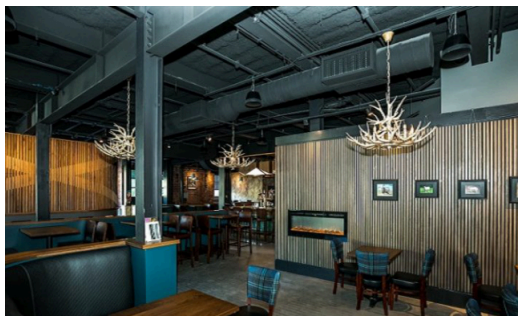

The Haven at the Brewery is a thoughtfully designed expansion of a beloved Jamaica Plain restaurant, crafted in close collaboration with Scottish restaurateur Jason Waddleton. This 2,500-square-foot space features distinct areas, including an 18-seat bar with custom mill work reflecting traditional Scottish craftsmanship, a cozy whiskey lounge, and dining rooms that evoke classic Scottish charm. A versatile private dining area with a performance stage enhances community engagement, while a 1,500-square-foot patio extends the experience outdoors with inviting landscaping.

Detailed craftsmanship, led by Dan Wallace of Order of the Arrow Woodworking, plays a pivotal role throughout, with custom mill work enhancing the space's warm and eclectic aesthetic. The design philosophy prioritizes intimacy and authenticity, blending traditional and modern elements to create a familiar yet fresh dining experience that honors Scottish traditions.
